


Junk modelling

A great way to exercise creativity, inventiveness and problem solving.



You will need:

- Empty egg boxes, shoe-boxes, cereal boxes, cardboard rolls, anything you can find in your home.
- It's easier to decorate cardboard than plastic, but there's no reason you can't have clean plastic bottles and yoghurt pots too.
- Then some PVA glue, lots of rolls of sticky tape, old magazines, paints, foil, old bottle tops, dried pasta, scraps of materials... anything goes as long as it's safe.

What to do:

The key here is to use your initiative.

- Clear a space so that nothing you want to keep is going to get incorporated into the design.
- Lay out all the materials
- Put aprons or old shirts on and tie hair back if needs be.
- With junk modelling, there are no rules as long as it's safe.
