



**New Dementia Support Service offers guidance and information
for people affected by dementia in Buckinghamshire**

The new easy to access, Dementia Support Service for people affected by dementia will be available from 1st April 2022. The contract has been awarded to Alzheimer's Society by Buckinghamshire Council and will replace the Memory Support Service delivered across the county since 2016.

The new service uses the Dementia Connect model, endorsed by the NHS long term plan and will provide timely information, and advice to individuals, their family, friends or carers throughout their journey with dementia, enabling them to live well, for as long as possible. The service will include telephone support, face to face support, Group Information sessions and self-management tools which include an online community, publications and factsheets and a directory of services.
